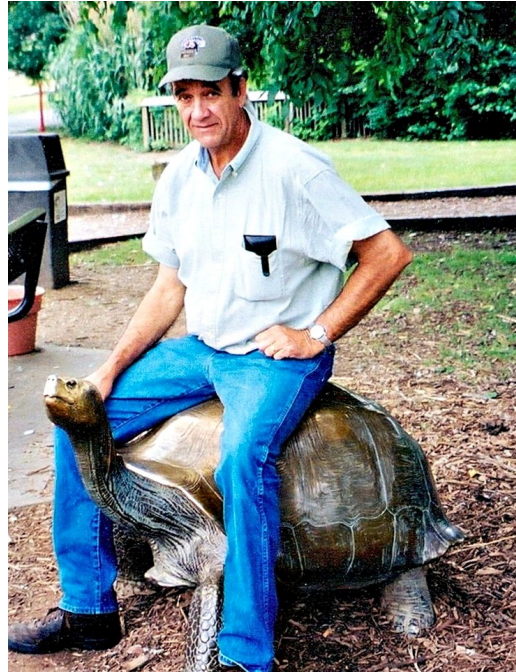
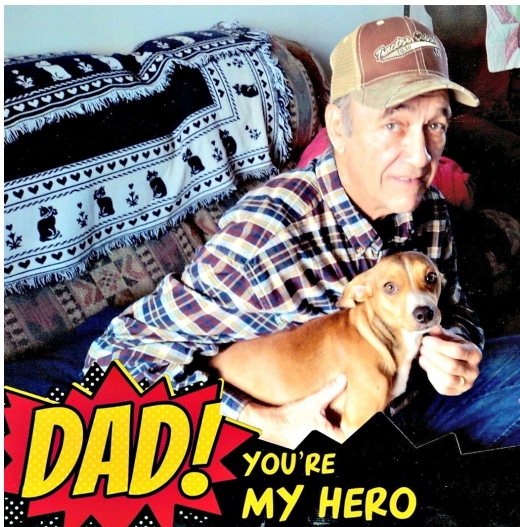


Leroy Taylor
