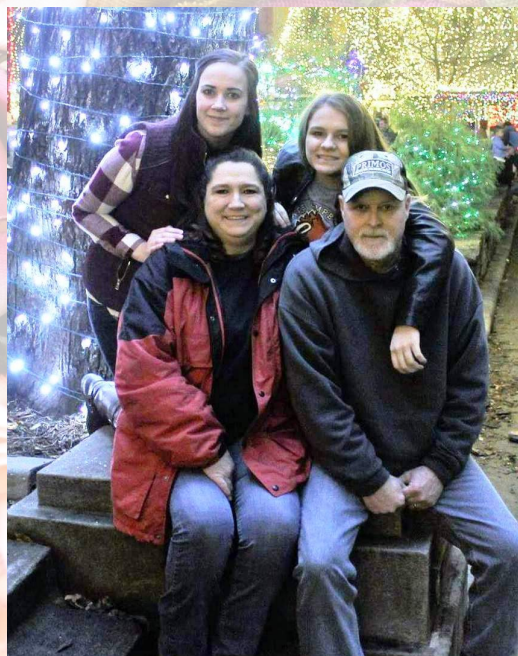


**Sandra Jean Taylor**
