## Ivan Earl Tyree

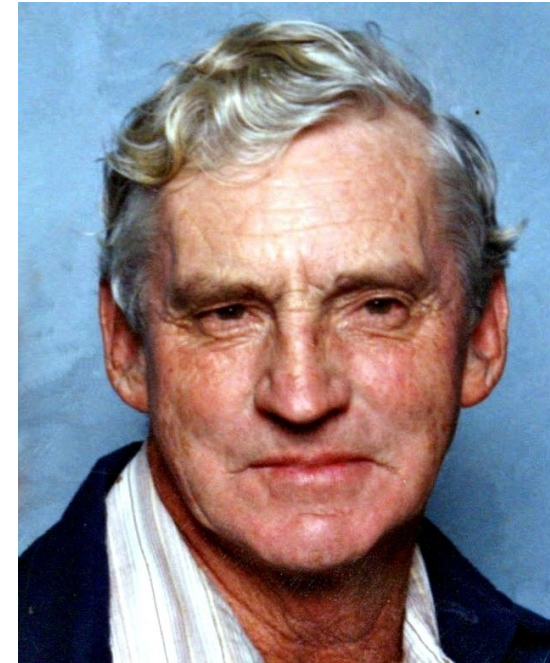
