

Donald Carl Umberson

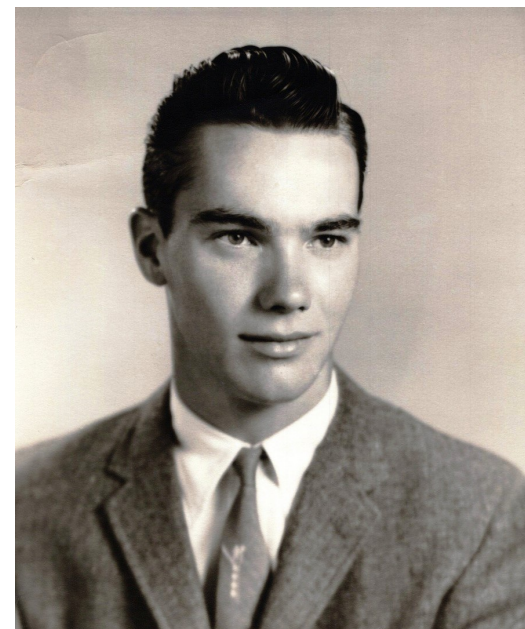
