Gabe was a wonderful son, brother and friend. His huge heart consumed everyone around him and filled all our lives with love.

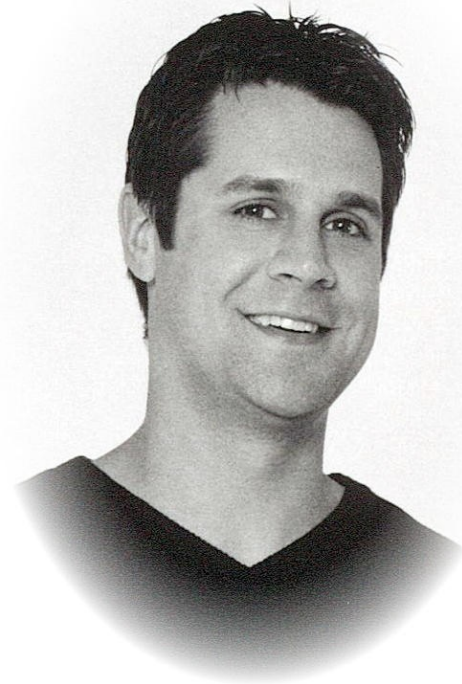
The anguish we feel from his passing and the agony of knowing he will no longer be part of our lives can only be diminished by remembering the joy and love he has given us for the past 34 years.
