

Robert Ray Ward



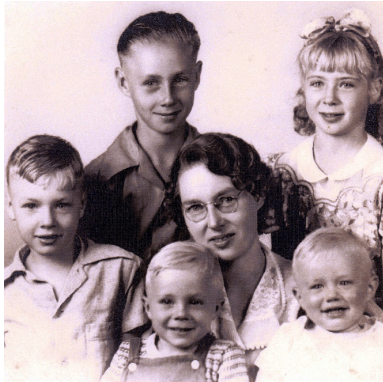
