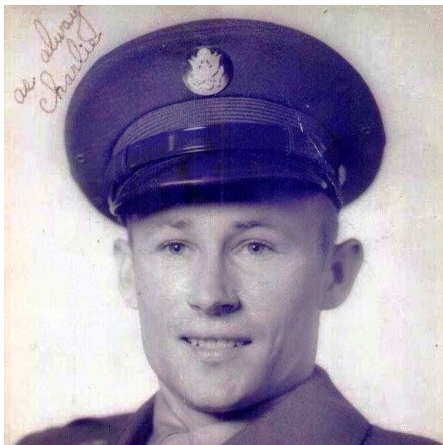


Charles Willey Washington
