Jack was of the Church of God Faith, a lifetime member of the Disabled American Veterans having

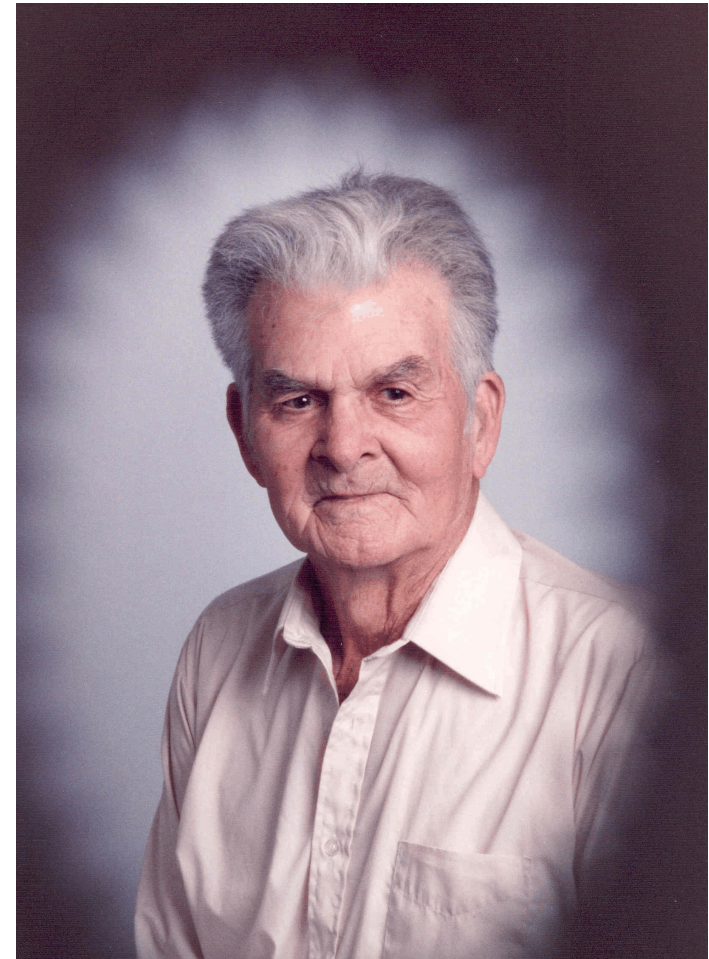
served in the United States Navy during World War II.
