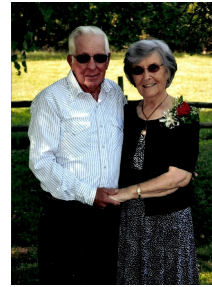
MOTHER LOVE
