

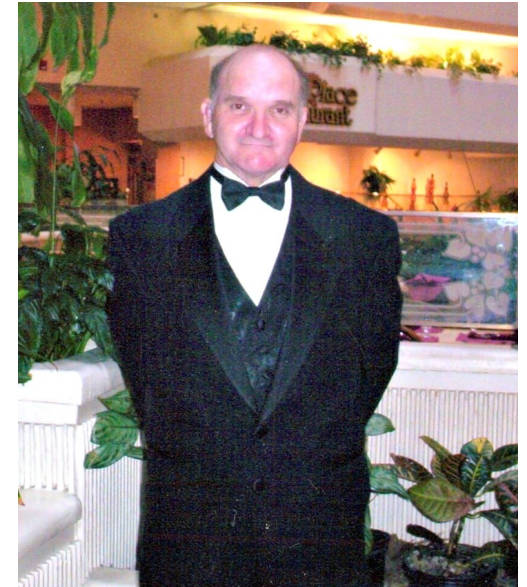
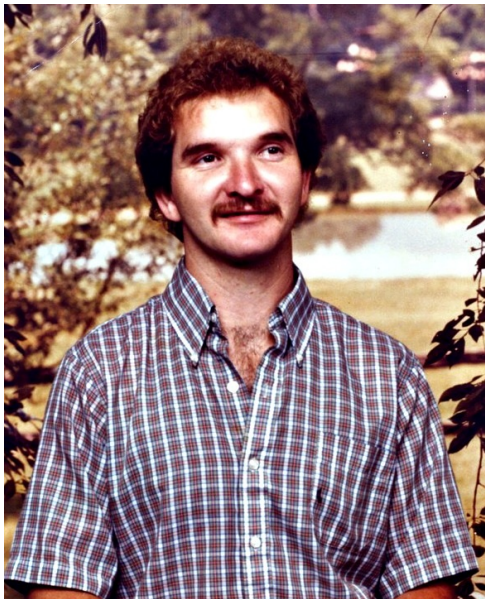
Charles Richard Yates
